Tayloe's recent professional achievements include collaborating with art advisor Camille Obering to organize the Jackson Hole debut of four major American artists: Milton Avery, Richard Diebenkorn, Helen Frankenthaler, and Joan Mitchell, for a widely praised and successful exhibition curated by Obering at Tayloe Piggott Gallery, then known as JH Muse Gallery. She was invited to travel to the prestigious international art fair Art Basel in Switzerland in June of 2009 to represent artist James Castle, a particularly gratifying experience since Tayloe was one of the first dealers to represent and develop a market for Castle before his work became well known and critically acclaimed within the international art world. She recently completed interior designs of three private residences in Teton County and San Francisco.
